Becoming a Safe Families volunteer is a unique and rewarding experience. Below are the requirements for each volunteer role.

\*Hosting is currently not available in NYC. Those who are interested in being hosts can become approved as Family Friends until hosting is available.



- **Applications:** Select New York City, NY as the Region on the online application. If the form asks for an agency, enter: Safe Families for Children NYC.
  - **Profile picture:** Please email a picture that we can upload to our database.
  - Married Applicants: Family Friend and Family Coach applications are completed as individuals because these volunteers are assigned individually. If both members of a married couple want to volunteer, then fill out separate applications (however references can overlap). Hosts who are a married couple can fill out one host application together.
- **Home screening:** Family Friends who desire to babysit children in their own home are required to have a home safety checklist, which can be completed by a Family Coach or staff member. When hosting becomes available, we will resume home screenings. We will contact host applicants to schedule a 2-hour home screening. The home screening includes an interview to expand on the questions asked in the application, a tour of the home, and a home safety checklist.

- **Background checks:** There are 3 background checks needed for volunteers to work with children: NY State fingerprinting, FBI fingerprinting, and child abuse registry. Volunteers are requesting to have these background checks as individuals desiring to volunteer with children through their local church. Instructions to conduct these background checks are on our webpage under "Forms" at www.newyorkcity.safe-families.org. Please scan and email fingerprinting results to nyc@safefamilies.net to be uploaded to our secure database. If you prefer to mail them, mail to Safe Families for Children Alliance, P.O. Box 380439, Brooklyn, NY 11238.
- Letters of Recommendation: It is our policy to vet Safe Families for Children volunteers whose lives reflect stable personal values and morals.
  - Volunteers need to choose three people who can attest to this aspect of their lives, one of which must be from pastoral leadership.
  - Please be sure to include the names and emails of three references when you complete your application. We will send the reference form directly to your references.
  - o Couples who are applying together may use the same references as long as they include both of your names on the form.
